

CHARACTERISTICS




FIG.2-TYPICAL FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




FIG.4-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE FORWARD SURGE CURRENT




FIG.3 - TYPICAL REVERSE




FIG.5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE
