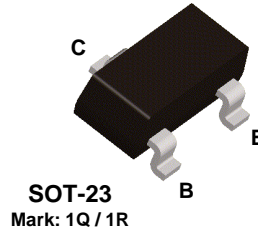
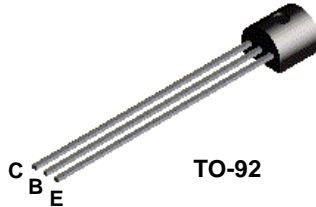

This device is designed for low noise, high gain, general purpose amplifier applications at collector currents from 1 $\mu$ A to 50 mA. Sourced from Process 07.

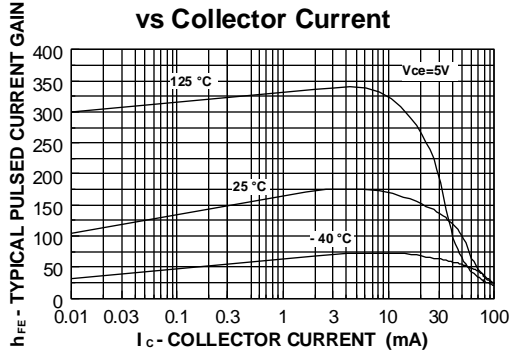

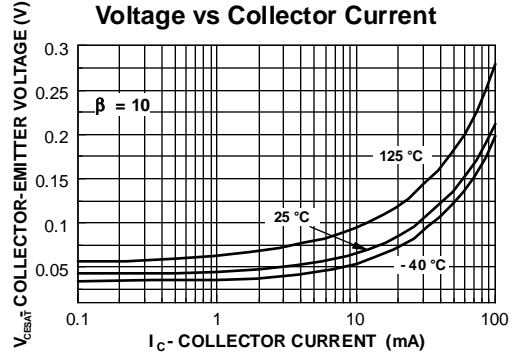

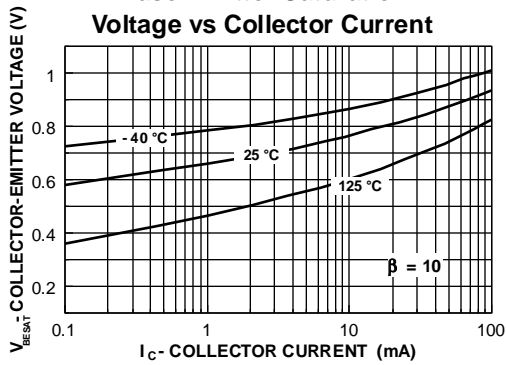
Typical Pulsed Current Gain vs Collector Current



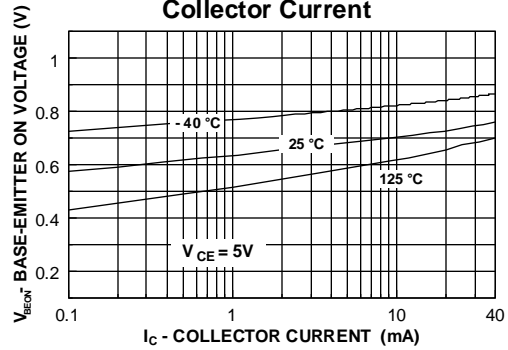
Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs Collector Current



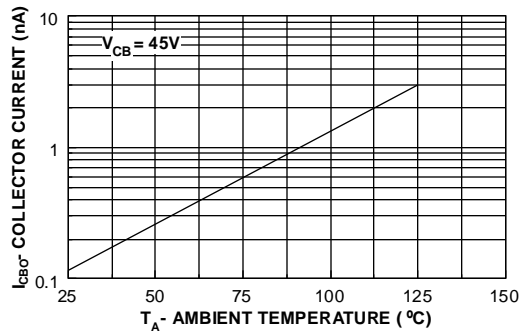
Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs Collector Current



Base-Emitter ON Voltage vs Collector Current

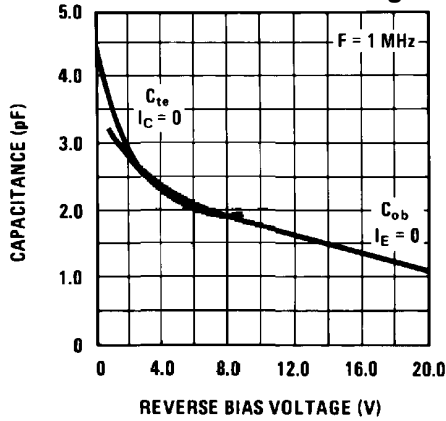


Collector-Cutoff Current vs Ambient Temperature

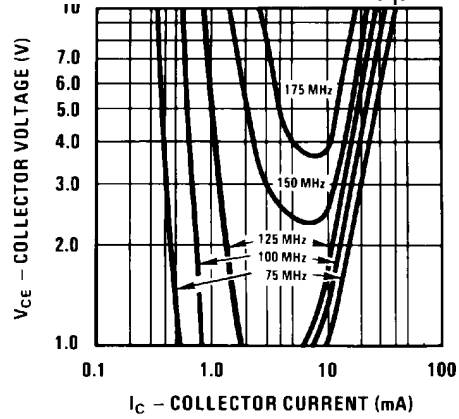

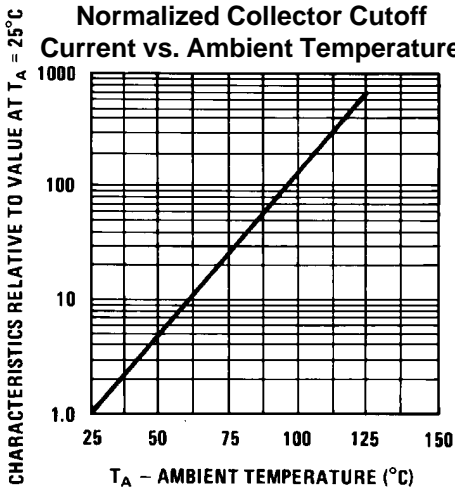
Input / Output Capacitance vs. Reverse Bias Voltage



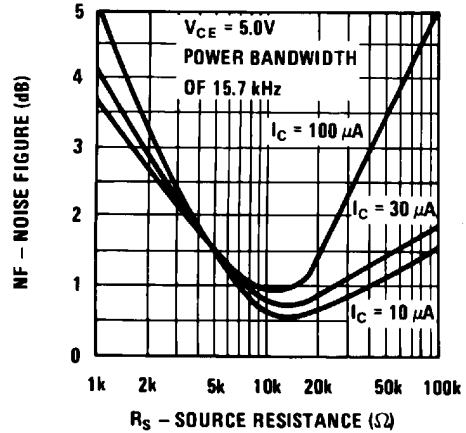
Contours of Constant Gain Bandwidth Product ( $f_T$ )



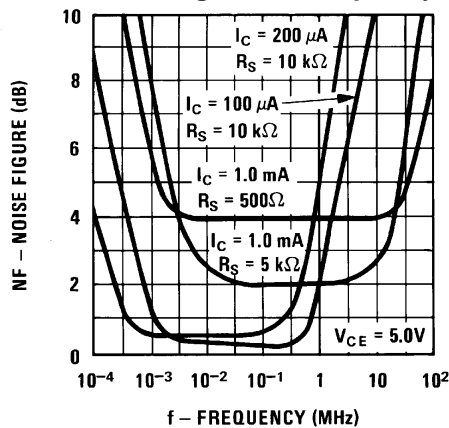
Normalized Collector Cutoff Current vs. Ambient Temperature



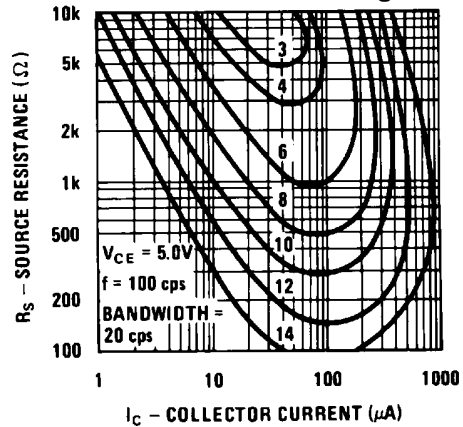
Wideband Noise Figure vs. Source Resistance



Noise Figure vs. Frequency

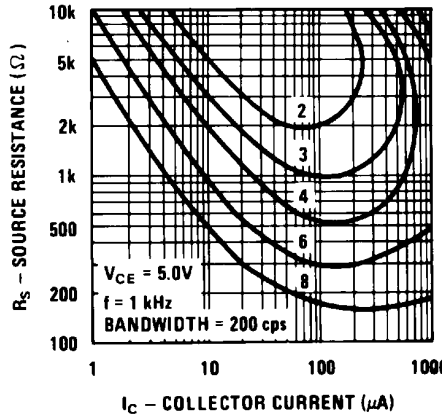


Contours of Constant Narrow Band Noise Figure

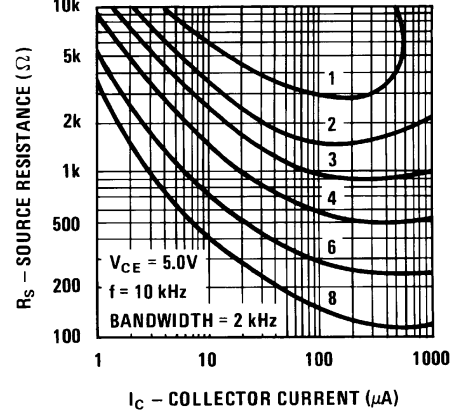

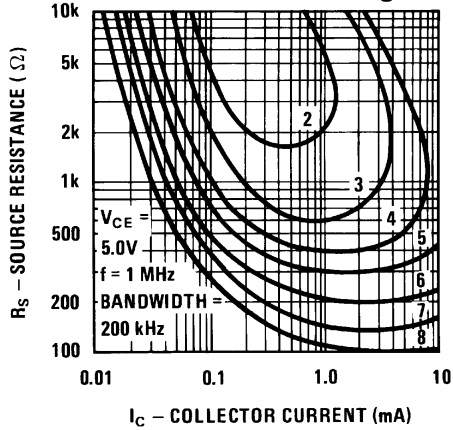
Contours of Constant Narrow Band Noise Figure



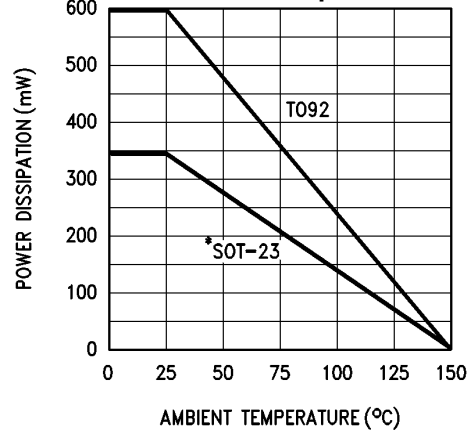

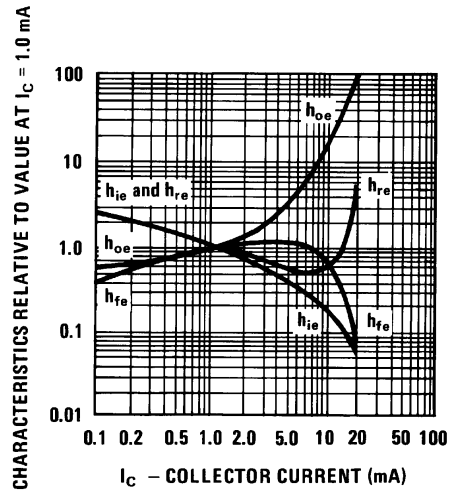
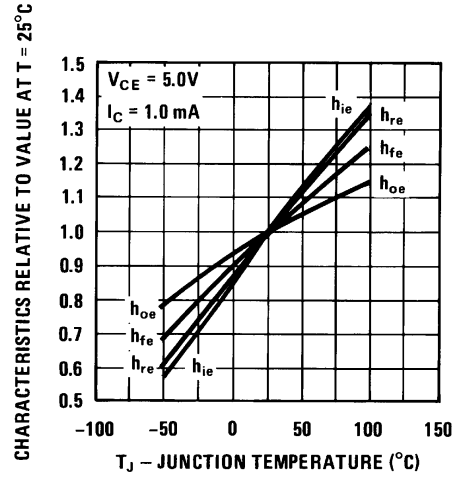
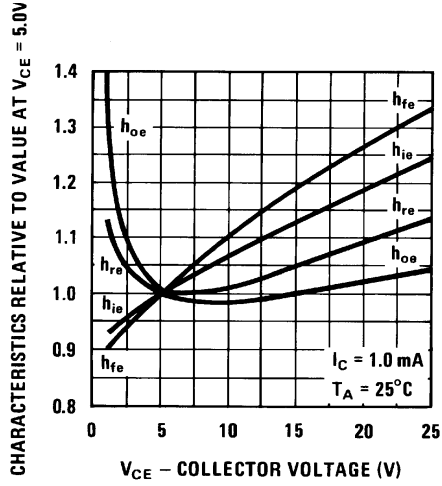


Maximum Power Dissipation vs. Ambient Temperature
