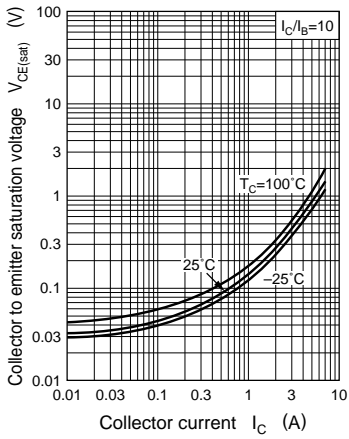
$I_C - V_{CE}$



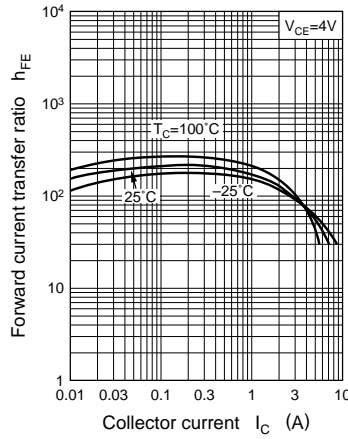
$I_C - V_{BE}$



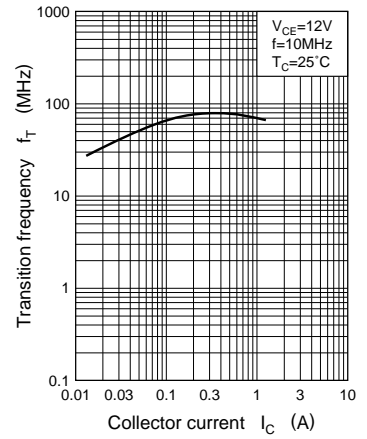

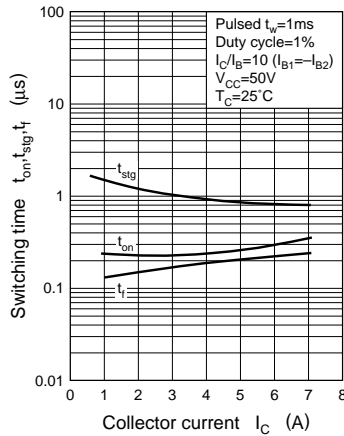

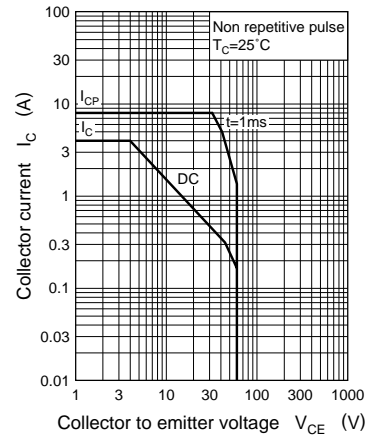
