



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


Fig.1. Maximum on-state dissipation, P_{tot} , versus rms on-state current, $I_{T(RMS)}$, where $\alpha = conduction$ angle.




Fig.4. Maximum permissible rms current $I_{T(RMS)}$, versus mounting base temperature T_{mb} .




Fig.2. Maximum permissible non-repetitive peak on-state current I_{TSM} , versus pulse width t_p , for sinusoidal currents, $t_p \le 20$ ms.




Fig.5. Maximum permissible repetitive rms on-state current $I_{T(RMS)}$, versus surge duration, for sinusoidal currents, f = 50 Hz; $T_{mb} \le 99$ °C.




Fig.3. Maximum permissible non-repetitive peak on-state current I_{TSM} , versus number of cycles, for sinusoidal currents, f = 50 Hz.






Fig.6. Normalised gate trigger voltage $V_{\rm GT}(T_i)/V_{\rm GT}(25^{\circ}{\rm C})$, versus junction temperature T_i .




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
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



Fig. 12. Minimum, critical rate of change of commutating current dI_{com}/dt versus junction temperature, $dV_{com}/dt = 20V/\mu s$.
