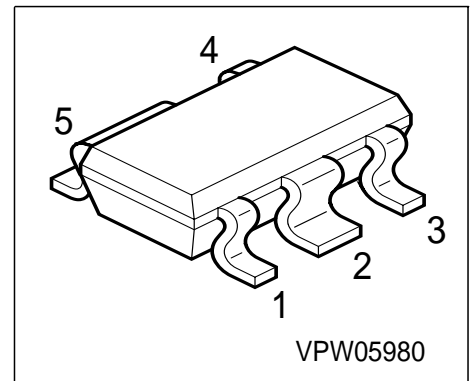

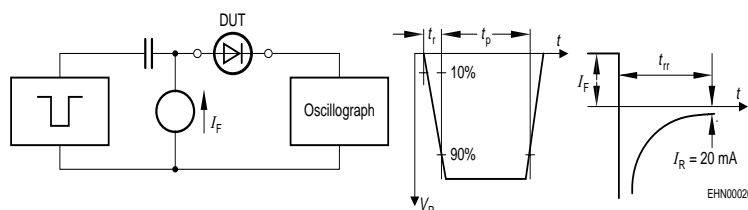

Test circuit for reverse recovery time

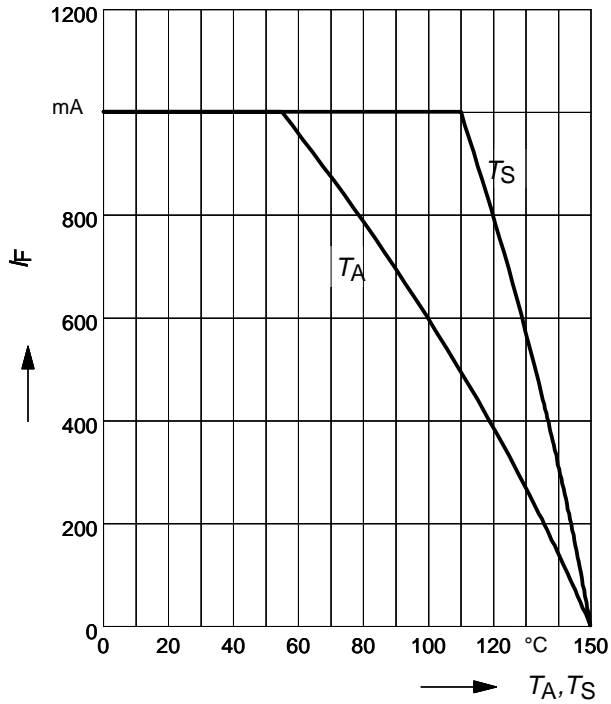


Pulse generator: $t_p = 100 \text{ ns}$, $D = 0.05$,
 $t_r = 0.6 \text{ ns}$, $R_i = 50 \Omega$

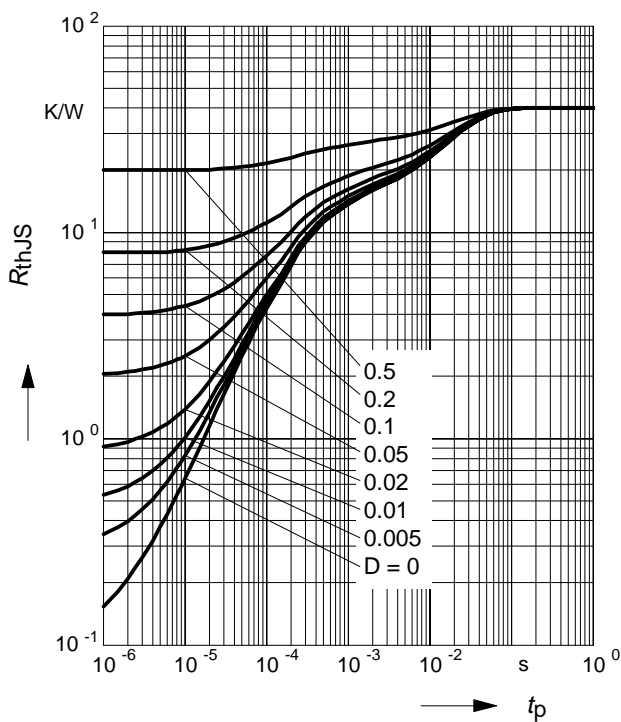
Oscilloscope: $R = 50 \Omega$, $t_f = 0.35 \text{ ns}$,
 $C \leq 1 \text{ pF}$

* Package mounted on epoxy

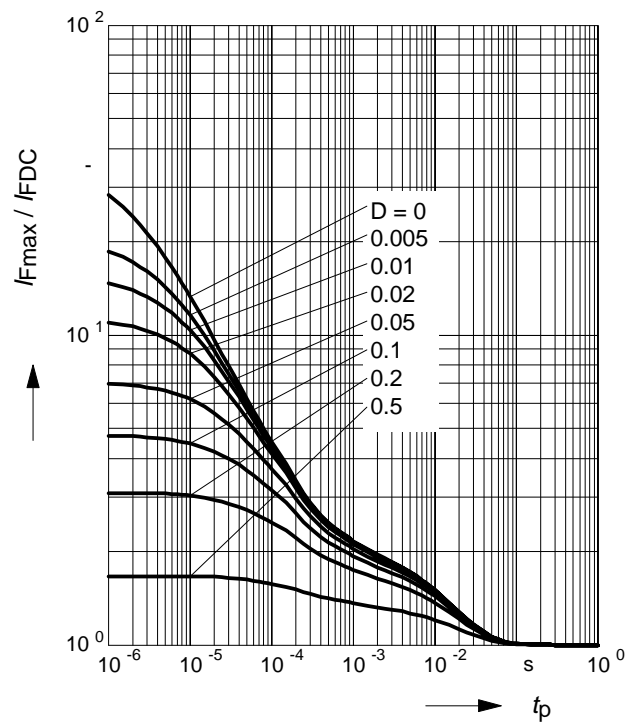


Permissible Pulse Load $R_{thJS} = f(t_p)$



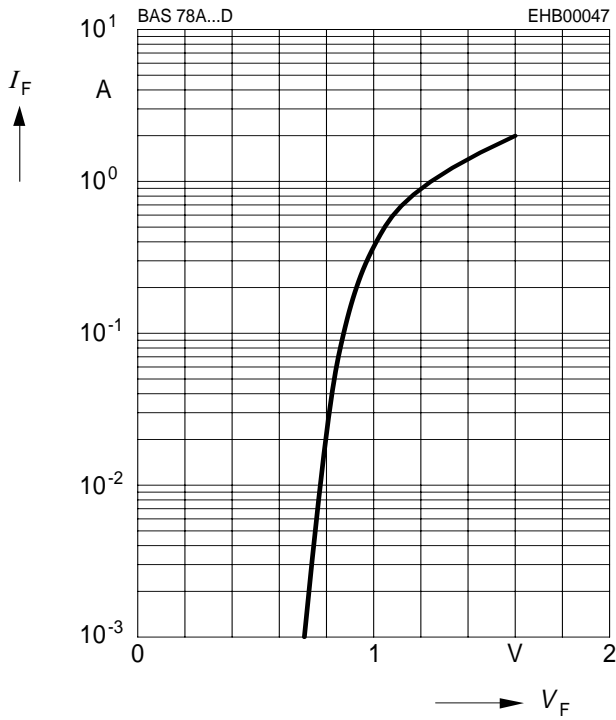
Permissible Pulse Load
